

**NOTICE OF AMMENDMENT TO 2022 ALLOCATION GRANT
THIRD PUBLIC HEARING**

The Guernsey County Commissioners applied to the Ohio Development Services Agency for funding under the 2022 Allocation & Neighborhood Revitalization Program on June 29, 2022. The County is eligible to apply for up to \$210,000.00 under the Allocation program and \$750,000.00 under the Neighborhood Revitalization Program, provided the County meets applicable requirements. On May 10, 2022, the County conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the eligible programs, how they may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements. Based on both citizen input and local assessment of the County's needs, the County is proposing to undertake the following activities and had submitted and requested the amount listed below
